

Governors SEN Information Report 2014 - 15

Year 1 Phonics Screening Check

7 out of 14 (50%) of pupils with SEN achieved the national standard last year in their phonics assessment, compared with 42% of pupils nationally.

Year 2 Phonics Screening Check

12 out of 17 (71%) of pupils with SEN achieved the national standard last year in their phonics assessment. Nationally, only 67% of pupils with SEN achieved the national standard.

Year 2 End of Key Stage One Results: Attainment

Pupils with SEN performed well at the end of key stage assessments. 17 pupils in year 2 are identified as SEN Support and 2 pupils are identified as having a Statement of SEN or Education, Health Care Plan (EHCP). Their results are collated in the table below.

Year 6 End of Key Stage Two Results: Progress

Our Y6 pupils on SEN Support or EHCP made the following progress over Key Stage 2 for the past three years. The only reliable previous data that can be used is from the Y3 entry baseline assessment to end-of-KS2-SATs.

Current Provision

There are currently 107 pupils on the SEND register. They are supported through a variety of types of provision both within the school and also through agencies such as Speech and Language Therapy Service, Multi Agency Behaviour Support Service, Occupational Therapy Services as well as Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services.

We currently have 32 teaching assistants supporting the children across the school. Many are deployed for children who have a Statement for Special Educational Needs or an EHCP.

Pupils who have Special Educational Needs may receive normal differentiated activities within the classroom or may have additional interventions outside the classroom. The range of provision available is outlined on Copnor Primary School's Local Offer which can also be found on the school website.
