What is an Independent Supporter?

Independent Supporters (IS) have local knowledge and experience of SEND, available to you the parent/carer and young person.

IS will offer specific, impartial, confidential support to parents and young people throughout the conversion process whilst their, Special Educational Needs, Statement is transferred to an Education, Health and Care plan.

What does an IS do?

Liaise with local services to help gather the information

Signpost to the other services.

Provide information on personal budgets.



How will IS do this?

We will help you to understand the process., keep you on track and make sure that your views are heard.
