- To describe how the body feels before, during and after exercise.
- To begin to use equipment to send the ball and receive the ball.
- To participate in simple games.



As a gymnast we will learn...

- To begin to use simple choreographic devices such as unison.

Geography

As geographers we will learn...

- To explain where we live and tell someone our address.
- To name the four countries in the UK *and locate them on a map.*
- To name some of the main towns and cities in the UK.
- To use simple maps and globes to identify the continents and oceans and understand that both a map and a globe show the same thing.
