As readers and writers we will learn...

- To read and spell words containing common suffixes full and less.
- To spell words which require a possessive apostrophe.
- To use commas when listing adjectives in noun phrases.
- To use subordinating conjunctions.
- To use adventurous vocabulary to suit the purpose of the writing.
- To use command and exclamation sentences



## Maths

As mathematicians we will learn...

- To solve problems involving division, using concrete resources and pictorial representations
- To recognise, find, name and write fractions  $\frac{1}{3}$ ,  $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $\frac{2}{4}$  and  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity
- To choose and use appropriate units to estimate and measure length/height to the nearest appropriate unit, using a ruler
- To compare and order lengths and heights.

- To give examples of how religious people celebrate.
- To explain my own ideas about a concept



## History

As historians we will learn...

- To recognise why people did things, why events happened, and what happened as a result.
- To compare two versions of a past event

## Science

As scientists we will learn...

- To identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses
- To find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching
- To use scientific vocabulary to describe my observations



## PE/ Games

As sports people we will learn...

- To master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, and co-ordination
- To participate in team games, developing simple tactics for attacking and defending
- To travel with, send and receive a ball and other equipment in different ways
- To perform dances using simple movement patterns



## Music

As musicians we will learn...

- To play simple repeated patterns within a composition.
- To know the term 'ostinato'
- To begin to choose sounds to create an effect on the listener
- To begin to compose short melodic patterns, using two or three notes
- To begin to compose short melodic patterns, including sequences of long and short sounds
