


English

As readers and writers we will learn...

- To add suffixes and prefixes to change the meaning of a word.
- To use a variety of conjunctions, including when, if and because.
- To understand the purpose of the four sentence types and use them confidently throughout our writing.
- To discuss and clarify the meaning of new vocabulary in texts we are reading.
- To infer about characters in our Guided Reading texts.



Maths

As mathematicians we will learn...

- To recognise and find the fractions $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a length, shape, set of objects or a quantity.
- To write simple fractions of amounts, for example, $\frac{1}{2}$ of $6 = 3$.
- To recognise the equivalence of $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$.
- To choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure temperature, mass and capacity.



As home learners we will learn...

- To read information books about things which interest us and talk about these with our families.
- To identify plants in and around my home.
- To take care of plants and our environment.





Science

As scientists we will learn...


- To observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into plants.
- To find out what a plant needs to stay healthy and to grow.
- To identify and name a variety of plants in their habitats, including micro-habitats.



Geography

As geographers we will learn...

- To identify weather patterns and make predictions.
- To observe and record weather such as temperature, rainfall and hours of sunshine.
- To compare and contrast weather in two locations.



PE/ Games

As sports people we will learn...

- To throw a ball with increased accuracy.
- To understand some concepts of game e.g. opponents and team mates.
- To show some understanding of simple tactics.
- To explore the different track and field activities involved within athletics.



Computing

As computer users we will learn...

- To demonstrate a good control when using still and video cameras.
- To create a sequence of images which together form a short animation.
- To begin to discuss the quality of an image and make decisions.
- To recognise that different forms of information (text, images, multimodal, sound) are more useful than some for different purposes.



Art

As artists we will learn...

- To use a variety of printing tools.
- To print on fabric and paper.
- To make my own printing blocks.
- To use repeating, overlapping, rotating and arranging shapes to create a printed pattern.
- To print by pressing, rolling, rubbing and stamping.
