Discussion Time

- 1. Will these changes happen to everyone at the same time?
 - Obually, puberty starts between ages 8 and 13 in girls and ages 9 and 15 in boys.
 - So, young people in the same age group are at different physical stages in their development.
 - Puberty starts when your body is ready. It's a bit like when you start to lose your milk teeth—it happens to everyone at different times.



- 2. Why are these changes happening?
 - Puberty is a time when someone's body begins to develop and change as they mature from being a child to an adult.
 - Your body will grow faster than at any other time in your life—except for when you were a baby.
 - Puberty is caused by sex hormones: chemicals which are released into the bloodstream to send messages to different parts of the body.
