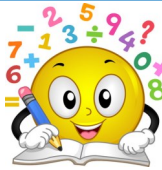
As readers and writers we will learn...



- To recap phonic knowledge to help our spelling and reading of new words.
- To sequence events in a story that has been read.
- To use third person consistently.
- To use past tense consistently throughout a piece of writing.
- To use coordinating conjunctions and begin to use some subordinating conjunctions, e.g. because and if.
- To select adjectives to form noun phrases to describe.
- To use of exclamation marks to indicate emotions.

Maths

As mathematicians we will learn...



- To count in steps of 2, 3, and 5 from 0, and in tens from any number, forward and backward
- To add and subtract numbers using concrete objects, pictorial representations, and mentally.
- To add and subtract 2-digit numbers and tens.
- To add and subtract two 2-digit numbers.
- To identify and describe the properties of 2-D and 3-D shapes.
- To recognise 2-D shapes on the surface of 3-D shapes.
- To compare and sort 2-D and 3D shapes.

- To describe the meaning of the symbol of light throughout Advent and Hanukkah.
- To describe, in simple terms, my responses to my own experiences of Advent and Hanukkah.

- To use words and phrases, such as before, after, past, present, then and now.

As artists we will learn...

- To make shapes from rolled up paper, straws, paper and card.
- To make shapes from clay and dough.

- To add texture to my work by adding materials and using tools.

- To pass and move with a ball.
