As sports people we will learn...

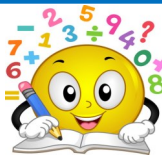
- To master a variety of basic movement patterns through dance routines.

Maths

As mathematicians we will learn...

- To choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure temperature, mass and capacity.
- To interpret and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables.
- To ask and answer simple questions by counting the number of objects in each category and sorting the categories by quantity.



D&T

As designers we will learn...

- To follow a simple recipe
- To combine ingredients in various ways.
- To apply hygiene rules to cooking
- To explain how some foods are made and some are natural.
- To measure and weigh food items using informal methods or formally (with support).
- I can use a variety of utensils safely.



Computing

As computer users we will learn...

- To demonstrate a good control when using still and video cameras.
- To create a sequence of images which together form a short animation.
- To begin to discuss the quality of an image and make decisions.
- To recognise that different forms of information (text, images, multimodal, sound) are more useful than some for different purposes.



As home learners we will learn...

- To read information books about things which interest us and talk about these with our families.
- To track the weather patterns we experience in the summer.



Geography

As geographers we will learn...

- To identify weather patterns and make predictions.
- To observe and record weather such as temperature, rainfall and hours of sunshine.
- To compare and contrast weather in two locations.



Art

As artists we will learn...

- To use a variety of printing tools.
- To print on fabric and paper.
- To make my own printing blocks.
- To use repeating, overlapping, rotating and arranging shapes to create a printed pattern.
- To print by pressing, rolling, rubbing and stamping.
