

Year 5 Homework Menu Topic: Where Land Meets Sea

Choose at least one of these projects to complete for this half term's homework. Bring your finished project into school by **Wednesday 19th July 2023**. You can bring it to school before then if you finish early, and complete more than one if you want to challenge yourself!

English – We are going to be learning a lot about coasts, oceans and how we can best protect them.

See what you can find out about Greta Thunberg's efforts and create a persuasive poster about how we can help protect the oceans.

Can you include modal verbs (must, will, could) and adverbs for possibility (surely, perhaps, potentially) to be persuasive and inspiring?

Music – Can you make a piece of music that could accompany a clip about how our oceans are being damaged by human activity?

Be creative and use online sources to help you!

Can you use pitch and tempo to impact how it makes your audience feel?

Geography – We are going to be learning about the specific features of a coastline and how they impact tourism and different locations.

Either...

Create a model of a typical coastline – research its features to help your learning.

OR

Create a geography dictionary on coastal key words that could be used to teach a future class.

Geography – We are also going to be learning about 'tourism', think about what that looks like in Portsmouth, specifically Southsea.

If you could add something to the Southsea Seafront area to make it more attractive to tourists, what would you add? Be creative!

Art – As we are going to be learning about tourism and how this affects coastal towns, can you design a T-Shirt that could be sold to tourists visiting Portsmouth?

Research design of other towns and see if you can use your knowledge of what we have learnt in school about landmarks and features to see if you can include these in your design.

Computing – Design a webpage that could be used to promote tourism in a coastal town/city that is not Portsmouth.

It could be somewhere you have visited on holiday or somewhere you plan to go.

Remember to include things such as tourist attractions, what can be done and shops/restaurants along the coast.
