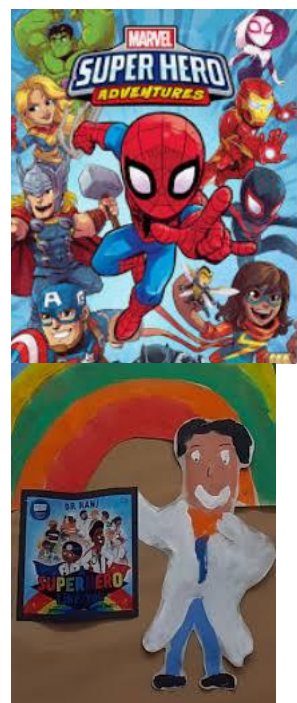


Reception Homework Menu Summer 1

Make your own 'Super' fruit or vegetable at home? Can you make up your own story using your super veggie as the hero?



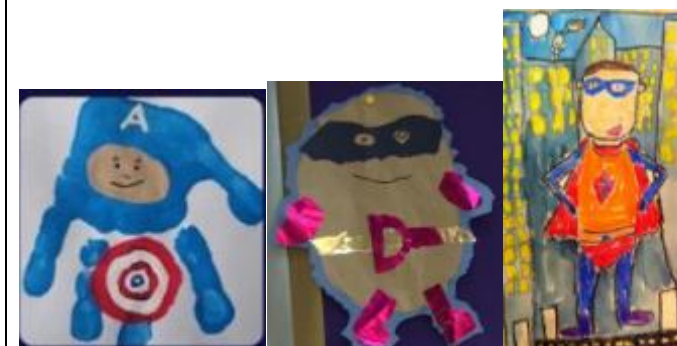
Think about real life superheroes. Who are they? What do they do that makes them a hero? How do they help us?
