This is what my Year 2 classroom looks like now. It might look a little bit different in September. The tables and chairs might be in a different position and the walls may have different decorations but there will be some things that are the same.



This is the Year 2 cloakroom. I will not use my Year 1 coat peg anymore; I will use my Year 2 coat peg when I am in Year 2. I will have a coat peg with my name on it in the Year 2 cloakroom. I can keep my coat and PE bag on my coat peg.



In the morning, I will arrive through the entrance to KS1 doors where my teacher will greet me.



I will walk to the Year 2 cloakroom and I will find my name in the Year 2 cloakroom. This is where I can hang my coat.



Then I will go to my classroom and I will put my water bottle in the classroom, my book bag in a box in the class room and my lunch box will go onto a trolley.

I can come into school wearing my PE kit on my PE days, or I can keep my PE kit in my classroom. In September I will find out what days my PE days are on.

When I need the toilet, I will use the same toilets that I have used in Year 1.

At playtime I will go onto the Key Stage 1 playground with the rest of Year 2. I can have my fruit snack during playtime.

At lunch time I will eat in the hall, just like I did in Year 1.



At the end of the day, I will collect all my belongings together. The class will walk quietly to their doors and listen to their name being called. I will leave through the KS1 Hall doors. This is where my parents can collect me.
