## Computing

Research information about the Anglo-Saxon era and create a PowerPoint presentation to present your work. Can you try to insert some pictures of Anglo-Saxon artifacts from the internet?

## English

Write a short diary entry as if you were an Anglo-Saxon child, describing a day in your life. Include details about what you did, what you ate, and how you felt about living in your village.

## DT

Make a 3D model of an Anglo-Saxon house. Plan your design by researching how houses used to look. Include features that reflect the daily life and culture of the Anglo-Saxons.

## Music

Compose a short chant that Anglo-Saxon warriors might have sung before a battle. Use repetitive rhythms and simple words, and practice performing it with strong, confident voices like you are preparing for battle!

## Art

Design your own Anglo-Saxon shield on a large piece of paper or cardboard, using traditional patterns like spirals, crosses, or animals. Using crayons, or markers could make it as detailed as possible, and feel free to add a handle on the back to make it feel real!

## Maths

Create some word problems involving Anglo-Saxon life, such as figuring out how many sheep a farmer has if he gains 12 more and originally had 25. Present your problem to the class and challenge your classmates to solve it!

## History

Make a timeline of the Kings in the Anglo-Saxon era.  
Can you include pictures and key facts to make it more detailed?
