You have up until **Wednesday 12th February 2025** so please take your time and produce something that you can work on over the half term.



Geography:

Create a map of the United Kingdom, labelling all four countries and their capital cities. Where else can you add to your map of the UK? Think of places special to you or your family.

Reading:

Visit your local library and find some books to share at home about the changing seasons. These could be non-fiction, fiction or even poetry books.

Let your teachers know which books you have particularly enjoyed so they can share them in class.

Science:

On a simple calendar, record the weather for each day and see how it changes throughout the term.

Could you find a way to measure how much rainfall we have or the wind speed? Be creative and share your findings with the class.

D&T:

In class, we will be making a simple turning mechanism to build a model windmill. Can you use resources from home (items from your recycling always work well) to create a model that includes a simple turning mechanism?

Writing:
