

## Year 6 Topic Homework: Portsmouth at War

Due in: Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2025

Choose one of these topic projects to complete this half term. You can bring it to school before the end of term if you finish early, and complete more than one if you want to challenge yourself!

**English** - Write a poem reflecting on WW2. There are many WW2 remembrance poems so you could research and read some as inspiration for your own poem.

**DT** - Have a go at cooking a wartime recipe for your people at home. You could take inspiration from the recipes on this website: <https://the1940sexperiment.com/100-wartime-recipes/>

**Art** - Design a sculpture (and even make it from any resources you may have at home, e.g. clay, plasticine, junk-modelling materials) that represents the events of WW2.

**Computing** - Use an animation program online to create a video, which could teach other children about the Blitz. (There are many free animation programs online but make sure you check this with your parent/carer first.)

**Geography** - Research WW2 battle grounds and locate them on a world map. Label them and record a brief history of the battle that took place there.

**English** - Plan and write a story about a child your age who was alive during WW2. Consider what their life would have been like and how it would have been different to your life now.
