## PE/ Games

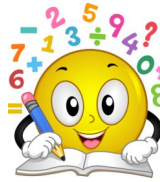
As sports people we will learn...

## RE

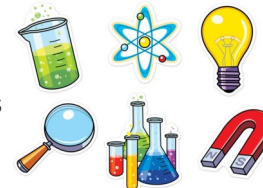
As thinkers we will learn...
