
Reception Homework Menu Topic: Once upon a time

This includes everyday transport such as cars, buses and bikes etc but also thinking more creatively about other ways to travel and where we could go. For example, travel to space or to different places around the world.

Use pens, pencils or paints to create a picture from

your favourite traditional story.

Go to the park and practise your gross motor skills such as crawling, running, jumping, skipping. Think of different ways you can travel using your body.



Read traditional stories together. Talk about your favourite character, why do you like them? Is there a character you do not like? Where is the story set? What do you think will happen next?



As you continue to learn new sounds in phonics, can you spot them in the environment and find things beginning with each sound. Can you read any words in your reading book?
