Science

Can you complete an investigation to see what happens to ice when you leave it in different places (e.g. in the garden, on top of a radiator etc.)? Use your inference skills to predict what might happen and why.

Write up your experiment as a poster, using reflection bubbles to show me what you discovered.

PE

Use unison and timing to teach the Icelandic Viking Thunder Clap to your family and then video your performance.

Computing

Research food eaten by the Vikings and design a menu for a Viking themed restaurant.

Your menu should include pictures as well as the logo/name of your Viking restaurant.

Maths

Use your knowledge of all your times tables (up to 12 times table) to design a times table game the class could use to help them practise their tables.

DT/ART

Make a Viking helmet using a variety of materials. Plan your work first, explaining what equipment you will use. Afterwards, evaluate your work. What went well? What would you do differently?

English

Design a fact sheet comparing the life of a Viking child to your own life in the modern day.

Use subheadings, facts and bullet points.

Geography

Use an atlas to look at the lands the Vikings invaded. Make a map to show which lands they settled on and explain why. Can you add coordinates onto your map?
