Design Your Spirit Animal

Think of an animal you feel connected to (it could be brave like a lion, clever like a fox, or gentle like a rabbit). Draw your animal and add patterns, colours, or symbols that show what you like or what makes you unique.

Write one sentence explaining why you chose that animal.

OR

Task 2: Light and Dark Drawing (Chiaroscuro)

Put a toy, piece of fruit, or cup on a table. Shine a torch or lamp at it so you can see shadows.

Use your pencil to shade from light to dark to show where the shadows fall. Try to make it look 3D, like it's popping out of the page!

Science- Heart Rate Investigation

First, find your pulse by placing two fingers on your wrist or the side of your neck. Count how many beats you feel in 1 minute – this is your heart rate.

Next, do 1 minute of exercise (star jumps, jogging on the spot, or dancing). Count your heart rate again straight after.

Rest for 2 minutes and check your heart rate one more time.

Record your findings in a table and answer these questions:

What happened to your heart rate when you exercised? Why do you think your body needs your heart to beat faster during exercise?
