As readers and writers, we will learn...

- To spot and suggest rhymes.
- Count or clap syllables in a word.
- Recognise words with the same initial sound.
- Engage in conversations about stories.
- Write some or all of their name.
- Write some letters accurately.
- Read some individual letters by saying the sounds for them
- Enjoying a range of singing songs and rhymes



Communication and Language:

As communicators we will learn...

- To enjoy listening to stories and remember what happens.
- To learn and sing a range of songs.
- To start a conversation with an adult or friend.
- To understand how to listen carefully and why listening is important.
- To use talk to work out problems and organize our thinking.
- To ask appropriate questions and understand simple questions.
- Listen carefully to rhymes and songs, paying attention to how they sound.



Expressive Arts and Design:

As creators, we will learn...

- To make marvellous marks with pencils, felt tips, crayons and chalk.
- To draw faces.
- To create seasonal wreaths (autumn).
- To show different emotions in drawings.
- To remember and sing entire songs.
- To enjoy and take part in action songs.
- To explore and play instruments learning how to play them in different ways.



Maths:

As mathematicians we will learn...

- To take part in finger rhymes with numbers.
- To consistently count 1 object for 1 number.
- To count up to 5 and then 10 correctly.
- To link numerals and amounts up to 5.
- To notice patterns and arrange objects.
- To develop fast recognition of up to 3 objects in different patterns.
