As you begin to learn new sounds in phonics, can you spot them in the environment or find things beginning with each sound.

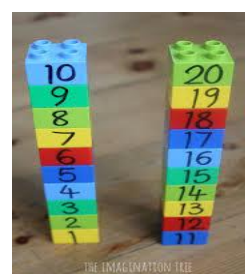


Go on a family walk to the woods or a local park. Can you spot any signs of autumn? You could also make a collection of autumn items that you find along your way.
