History

Comparing the Past and Present

- Find out what changed in the 1921 census.

Write two or three sentences describing the new information collected and what it tells us about how life was changing.

- Compare a family from the Victorian census with one from 1921 (or your own family today, if you prefer).

What differences do you notice in jobs, family size, or where people lived?

PE

Research a famous paralympic sport.

Write out the instructions for it, or make a video of you explaining it, so you can teach others how to play.

Choose one of these topic projects to complete this half term. You can bring it to school before the end of term if you finish early, and complete more than one if you want to challenge yourself!

Science

Research an animal(s) and write a detailed report to describe appearance, features, characteristics, adaptation to environments, habitat, labelled diagram etc.

OR

Look at a variety of plants. Select 3-6 plants.

Can you put different plants into groups according to their characteristics?

- Describe the characteristics of each plant.
- Assess plant habitats and describe what environmental conditions the plants will need to adapt to.



Writing

Pick a setting from your favourite movie, TV show or book and write out a setting description.

Aim to include relative clauses, past perfect tense and adverbials.

DT

For homework, design and make a small textile accessory inspired by your waistcoat project – such as a mini pocket, badge, or patch. Use scrap fabric or old clothes, cut out your design using a simple template, and join pieces with a running stitch or fabric glue. Add a fastening or decoration to make it functional or decorative. When finished, write a short evaluation explaining what went well, what you would improve, and how your design meets your criteria.
