


How did we learn to fly?

Science

As scientists we will learn...

- Identify stages in the life cycles of different animals, including humans.
- Describe the basic survival needs of animals.
- Explain how to take care of personal hygiene.
- Describe some positive effects of exercise.
- Identify foods in different food groups.



PE/ Games

As sports people we will learn...

- Move in time with a beat showing control and coordination.
- Dance with control and use dance movements at different levels
- Travel using different movements such as; jumping, gesturing and turning
- To stop the ball and use the sole, inside or outside of your foot.
- To pass and use the inside of foot,
- To dribble and use the inside of foot, head up and keep the ball close to you



Music

As musicians we will learn...



- To use their voice to create a variety of sounds.
- Use dynamics to create atmosphere.
- Correctly identify some instruments and changes in dynamics in a piece.
- Explain how the same instrument can have many different sounds.
- Compare two pieces of music using some musical vocabulary to describe the changes in tempo, dynamics and timbre.
- Notate and write down their motif in note form.
