PSHE

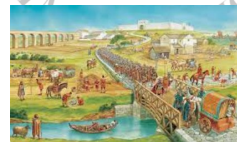
As citizens we will learn...

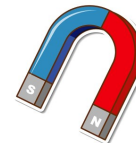
As design technologists we will learn to...
