

### Science

Can you create an information poster for Year 3's explaining how we classify animals and how food chains work.

Try to make it as creative as possible including science-specific vocabulary.

### Maths

### Writing

Pick one of the writing tasks.

#### Task 1: Persuasive Letter

Write a letter to someone at school asking them to help protect animal habitats. You could mention reducing litter, creating quiet areas, or planting green spaces.

#### Task 2: Portal/Adventure Story

Write a short story like *Journey* by Aaron Becker.

Include a character entering a magical portal and going on an adventure with challenges and discoveries.
