Topic: We are all heroes

Below are some different activity ideas you can have a go at over the next half term. You can share some pictures on Tapestry or bring in what you have created. It would be lovely for us to see them and share them with the class. This topic is about heroes. We will be looking at different types of heroes, not just superheroes but also real-life heroes.

During the first couple of weeks of our new topic we be focusing on the story of Supertato. Can you create your own super veggie using something from home. You could make it, draw it, paint it whatever you choose. Make sure to give it a name and show us your creation.



Visit your local library. How many different books can you find about heroes? Are they fiction or non-fiction books?

You could choose your favourite and bring it in to share with the other children in your class.



As part of our topic, we will be thinking about people who help us.

Speak to your family and friends and find out if any of them are or know real life heroes. What do they do to help people around them or to make them a real-life hero?

You could then ask this grown up if they would like to come into school and share their job or story with the children in EYFS.
