#### Science:

Can you collect as many different leaves from trees as possible and find what they have in common?

Could you create a rubbing of a leaf?

Spot any plants around and identify the parts of the plants.

#### Maths:

Do a scavenger hunt around your house and find:

- The tallest object
- The longest object
- The shortest object
- The heaviest object
- The lightest object

Draw a picture and show your measurements.

#### History:

Visit your local library and find some books about some of the explorers we will be learning about this half term: Christopher Columbus, Dame Ellen MacArthur, Matthew Henson and Mary Kingsley.

#### Writing:

Read a traditional tale (Little Red Riding Hood, Goldilocks, The Three Little Pigs) and re-write the story.

Ensure your sentences include capital letters, spaces between words and full stops.

Challenge: Can you add an exclamation mark and/or an adjective?

#### Music:

When you are singing a song, try and change the tempo. Can you sing it faster? Can you sing it slower?

#### Art:

Can you create a piece of street art influenced by **My Dog Sighs**? You could use colouring pencils, paint or pencil.
