Please select one of these activities that you would like to create and share with the class.

#### **Writing:**

Write at least three sentences describing a UK coastline. Use some of these ideas:

- What does the coast look like?
- What can you see, hear, and feel at the beach?
- Use exciting adjectives (e.g., "The golden, soft sand stretches along the windy shore.")

☀️ Challenge: Try using a compass direction in your description (e.g., "The rough waves crash on the eastern coast of England.")

#### **Computing:**

Use a digital tool (e.g., Google Maps with an adult, a simple drawing app, or a printed map) to:

- Label the UK seas and oceans
- Mark at least 3 coasts in the UK
- Use arrows and compass points (N, E, S, W) to explain where they are.

☀️ Challenge: Find a picture of a UK coast online and explain which coast it is!

#### **Geography:**

Explore your locality and the physical features of our coastline. Take a walk with an adult to visit the coast near our city (or think about a time you have been there before). Look around and find at least three physical features, such as: Cliffs, Beaches, Harbours, Sand dunes, Waves.

📷 Challenge: Take a picture or draw a picture of what you see!

#### **DT:**

Design a healthy lunch that includes a variety of food groups!  
You can even make it and then take a picture of it.

#### **Art:**

Draw or paint a UK coastal scene.  
Include some physical features such as:

- 🏖️ Beaches
- 🏔️ Cliffs
- 🌊 Waves
- 🌿 Dunes
