

Year 6 Topic Homework Menu: Survival of the Fittest!

Choose one of these topic projects to complete this half term. You can bring it to school before the end of term if you finish early, and don't forget you can complete more than one!

English:

Make a poster about the variation in your family.

You could include information about:

- Eye colour
- Hair colour
- Ear lobes
- Double jointed or not

Who are you more similar or different to in your family and why?

Find out as much as possible about your family tree and create it using photos.

Science:

Research an animal which has adapted to its environment. The more unusual, the better.

OR

Make up your own creature and explain how it has adapted to its surroundings.

OR

How did our different body parts evolve? Make a diagram of the human body with labels pointing to why you think each part developed e.g. eyebrows to stop sweat going in eyes, overhanging nose to gather more oxygen etc (will require research!).

Computing:

Why not create a PowerPoint animation about evolution using our learning throughout the term, and your own research?

It could be a chronological animation that shows how humans have evolved, feature dinosaurs, or be a story about the life of a famous evolutionary biologist.

Art:

Draw your own 'March of Progress' picture showing the development of humans from apes, with labels for each stage.

Make a collage of cut out pictures of different animals with labels around them showing how they have adapted over time.

Maths:

Using this QR code, chose 3 different maths investigations to complete (you can change the age and challenge level to find ones perfect for you.

Not only answer them but create an explanation (could be written in a paragraph, or presented as a poster etc) to show **how** you solved it.
