World Cup Learning Project

As changes to our homework are happening, we are kicking things off in an exciting way, by launching a World Cup-themed home learning project, designed to build on oracy skills and the excitement of the children about this event. This is an extended homework project lasting over the next 2 weeks.

All children are invited to present information about any aspect of the World Cup, for example, one of the countries taking part; facts about winners or a famous footballer who has played in a World Cup. The finished work can focus on geography, culture, art or football-related learning. It can be presented as a fact file, artwork or a model. Each child should be able to talk about what their homework is about and share some facts. Children can also make use of footballer books they own to support their project idea or to be a part of it.
