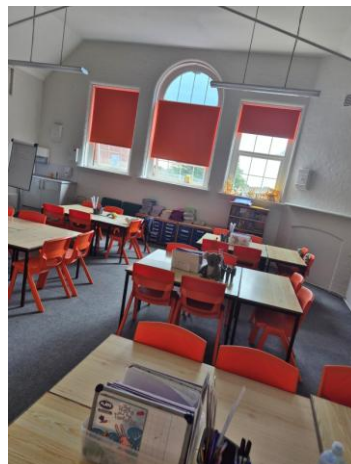

This is what my Year 4 classroom looks like at the moment. It might look a little bit different in September. The tables and chairs might be in a different position and the walls may have different decorations but there will be some things that are the same.



In the morning, I will enter school through the Year 4 door where a Year 4 teacher will be waiting on the door ready to greet me. I will say goodbye to my adult and go up the stairs to the Year 4 cloakroom.



This is the Year 4 cloakroom. I will not use my Year 3 locker anymore but I will have my own Year 4 locker. I can keep my coat and lunch box in my locker.

In the morning, I will take my water bottle into class.

When I need the toilet, I will use the Year 4 toilets.



Sometimes I might work in the Year 4 shared area and use the Year 4 library.



At lunchtime Year 4 eat their lunch first and go out to play second. Unlike when I was in Year 3, I will now eat my lunch in the Key Stage 2 Hall. I will eat my lunch and then go outside.



Year 4 play on the middle playground at break times and lunch times the same as I did in Year 3.



When I have PE, it might be outside in the Year 3/4 playground, outside in the Year 5/6 playground or in the KS2 hall.



At the end of the day my grown up will collect me from one of the Key Stage 2 hall doors.
