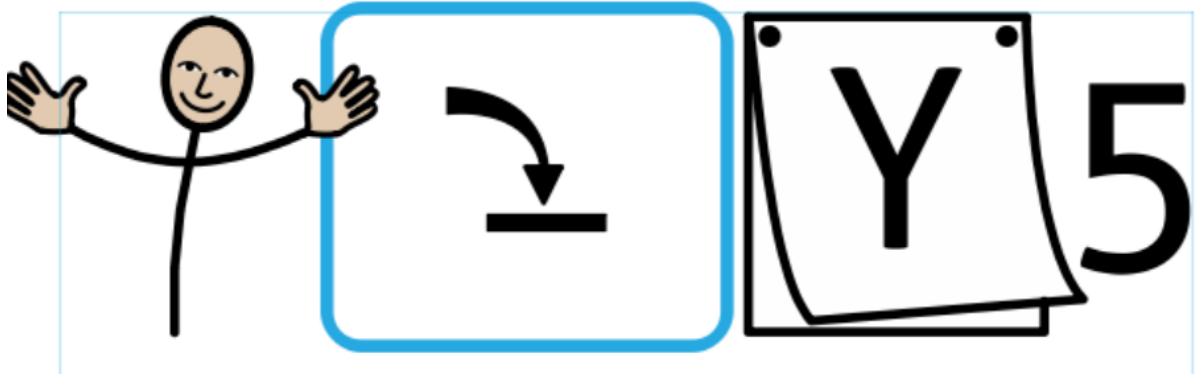




Welcome to Year 5

When I come back to school on Tuesday 1st September 2026, I will be in Year 5 in Banksy class.



Miss Lowe will be my teacher. She will help me learn.
